I. Background information

1. Article 22, paragraph 7, of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification states that “The United Nations, its specialized agencies, and any State member thereof or observers thereto not Party to the Convention, may be represented at sessions of the Conference of the Parties as observers. Any body or agency, whether national or international, governmental or non-governmental, which is qualified in matters covered by the Convention, and which has informed the Permanent Secretariat of its wish to be represented at a session of the Conference of the Parties as an observer, may be so admitted unless at least one third of the Parties present object.” Rules 6 and 7 of the rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP), adopted by decision 1/COP.1, contain provisions to similar effect. Decision 26/COP.1 contains provisions on accrediting non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations to the first and subsequent sessions of the COP.

II. Introduction

2. Since May 2022, the UNCCD secretariat has received requests for accreditation to the COP from intergovernmental organizations, non-governmental and civil society organizations and business and industry entities. This document includes the lists of observers that have fulfilled the requirements established by the COP and that are recommended by the secretariat. The list of observers already accredited at previous sessions of the COP is contained in documents ICCD/COP(15)/14 and ICCD/COP(15)/14/Add.1, entitled “Accreditation of intergovernmental organizations, civil society organizations and representatives from the private sector, and admission of observers. Note by the secretariat”.¹

3. Annex I of this document contains the recommended intergovernmental organizations for accreditation to the sixteenth session of the COP (COP 16) while annex II contains the non-governmental and civil society organizations, and annex III the business and industry entities.

III. Recommendation

4. In accordance with the above-mentioned provisions, the COP, at its sixteenth session, may wish to accredit as observers the intergovernmental organizations listed in annex I, the non-governmental and civil society organizations listed in annex II and the business and industry entities listed in annex III.
