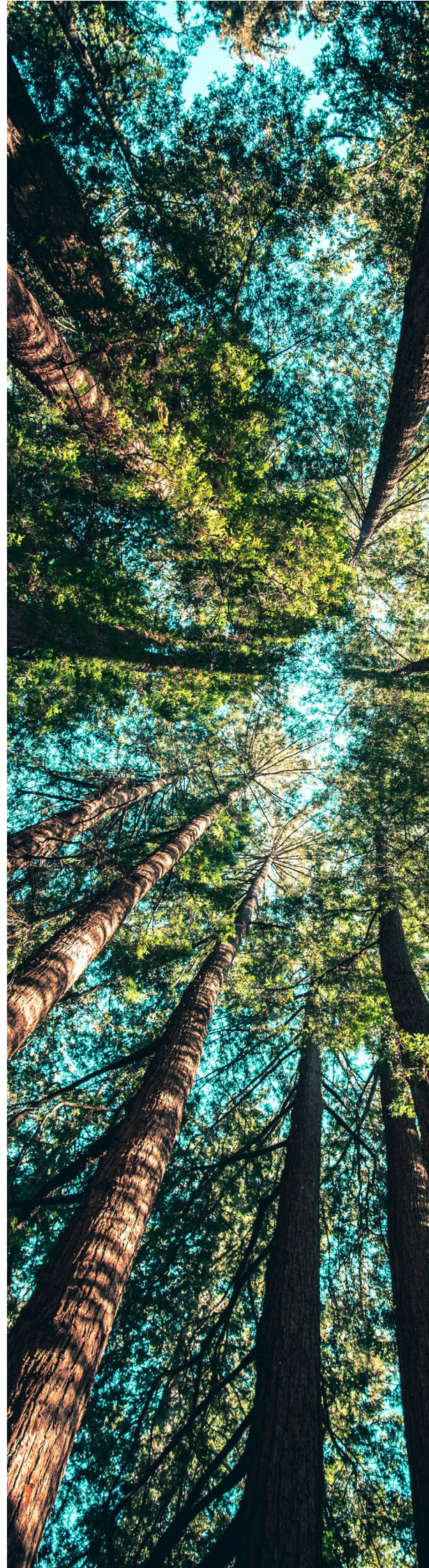

What is Business for Land?

Business for Land (B4L) is the UNCCD Global Mechanism’s private sector engagement platform, mandated by COP16 Decisions 6/COP.16, (Riyadh, December 2024). It is the only private sector engagement mechanism embedded directly in a Rio Convention by decision of its 197 Parties.

B4L’s overarching aim is to mobilize business action in support of restoring 1.5 billion hectares of degraded land by 2030 to achieve Land Degradation Neutrality (SDG 15.3) and Drought Resilience.

Business Operations & Value Chains

Setting targets, implementing positive practices, and disclosing impacts across operations and value chains. B4L engages with global standard setters to ensure the inclusion of land issues and align public and private frameworks. B4L also supplies companies with capacity-building tools that support the adoption of positive practices.

Finance

B4L supports the creation of sustainable finance solutions for land restoration and drought resilience. B4L facilitates the mobilization of funds through the development of the [Drought Resilience Investment Facility \(DRIF\)](#), a blended finance mechanism backing sustainable farming, water access and nature-based solutions to unlock private sector investment.

Advocacy

B4L provides a platform where businesses can advocate for enabling policies. Within the UNCCD as well as other forums, advocacy efforts are aimed at fostering a business environment conducive to sustainable land and water management. The Champions’ Council is part of these efforts, and at national level, business associations can host Business4Land Hubs to spread the word.

The B4L Call to Action

A Business Agenda for Restoring 1.5 Billion Hectares of Land and Increasing Drought Resilience

We, the undersigned companies and organizations, recognize the urgent need to address land and soil degradation as well as drought to protect ecosystems, communities and economies worldwide. In alignment with the UNCCD's goal to restore 1.5 billion hectares of land by 2030, we pledge our commitment to combating land degradation, desertification and drought through the Business for Land (B4L) initiative.

THE B4L PILLARS

By signing this Call to Action, signatories commit to contributing to one or more of B4L's pillars, in alignment with the UN Global Compact Principles.

1. Business Operations & Value Chains

- Assess and disclose land, soil and water impacts, dependencies and risks in corporate disclosures.
- Integrate measurable targets to minimize and reverse impacts across operations and supply chains.
- Report transparently on progress, with data shared with UNCCD to communicate collective progress.

2. Finance for Land Restoration

- Realign financial portfolios toward sustainable land, soil and water management.
- Develop and promote sustainable financial solutions for restoration and conservation.
- Provide philanthropic support for community-led restoration projects.

3. Advocacy & Collaboration

- Advocate for policies enabling sustainable land, soil and water management in business.
- Engage in multistakeholder dialogues, sharing knowledge and land-positive innovations.
- Collaborate with governments and civil society, particularly at UNCCD COPs.

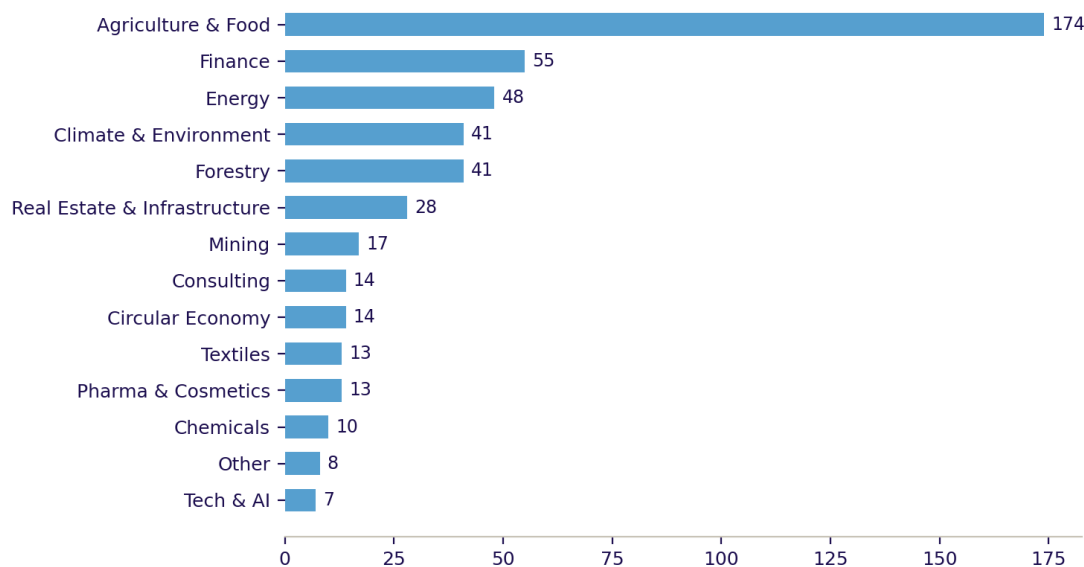
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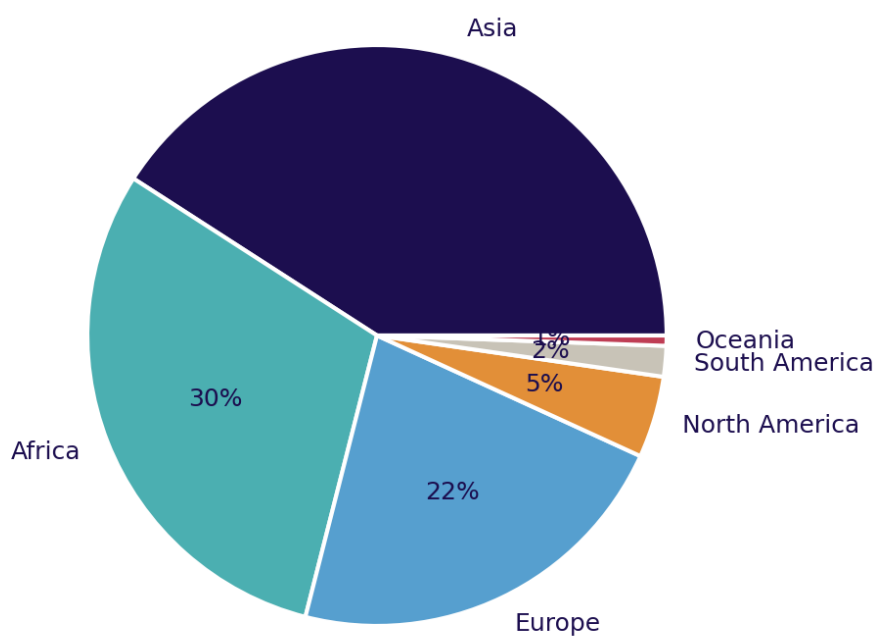

What Hubs Do, and How to Open One

FOUR CORE FUNCTIONS

Knowledge Exchange & Capacity Building

Promote good practices, tools and metrics for sustainable land, soil and water management; facilitate peer-to-peer learning.

Convening & Engagement

Bring together companies, SMEs, financial institutions and business associations through meetings, roundtables and missions.

Investment & Action Facilitation

Channel evidence-based business perspectives into project pipelines; encourage blended finance without assuming ownership.

Policy Dialogue

Facilitate dialogue with development finance institutions and donors; contribute business perspectives to national and UNCCD processes.

HOW TO OPEN A HUB

- 1 Eligible entities: business associations, chambers of commerce, foundations, public-private partnerships, or other institutions capable of engaging the private sector.
- 2 Submit an Expression of Interest via a transparent, merit-based, competitive process coordinated by the UNCCD Secretariat.
- 3 Evaluation criteria: alignment with UNCCD/B4L, institutional credibility, governance, operational capacity, and private sector reach.
- 4 Review by the B4L Hub Selection Committee (Champions' Council), with final confirmation by the Secretariat.
- 5 Designation includes a Memorandum of Understanding, risk-based due diligence, and a fixed term aligned with UNCCD COP cycles.

The Host Entity operates independently, coordinates Hub activities, and serves as the primary liaison with UNCCD — but does not represent UNCCD or enter into obligations on its behalf.

Business4Land Hubs

B4L Hubs are regional platforms that bring the initiative’s governance and programming closer to local business ecosystems — hosted by a qualified national institution in each country.



B4L France Hub

Consortium with World Living Soil Forum (Moët Hennessy / LVMH), Entreprises pour l’Environnement, Office française de la Biodiversité and Club de Giverny

Consortium host: The B4L France Hub is hosted by a consortium bringing together four organizations. The **World Living Soil Forum** (WLSF), created by Moët Hennessy/LVMH and co-organized with ChangeNOW, is the only private-sector forum dedicated to soil health. **Entreprises pour l’Environnement** (EpE), founded in 1992, unites some sixty major French and international companies and serves as the French partner of the WBCSD. The **Office Français de la Biodiversité** (OFB) is France’s public biodiversity agency, created in 2020 to protect and restore ecosystems nationwide. The **Cercle de Giverny** is a think-and-do tank convening the annual Giverny Forum, France’s leading gathering for sustainable business.

By COP18: By COP18, the WLSF aims to have run its French B4L Hub through multiple annual editions, held two member meetings a year to share the B4L roadmap and best practices, and expanded its international reach through satellite events connecting the U.S., China and Brazil.



B4L China Hub

China National Sand Control and Desert Industry Society (CNSC)

The B4L China Hub translates the initiative’s three pillars into a localized action framework, helping Chinese enterprises move from “land resource users” to “land regeneration partners” through supply-chain transformation, industrial land restoration and ESG disclosure.

By COP18: By COP18, the Hub aims to have mobilized Chinese enterprises across land-friendly supply chains, industrial restoration models such as photovoltaic-based desert projects, and ESG disclosure aligned with TNFD and SBTN — while connecting members to the national Three-North Shelterbelt Program and the green Belt and Road Initiative.

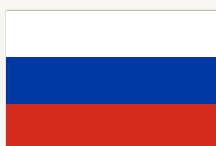


B4L Mongolia Hub

Business Council of Mongolia (BCM)

BCM, an established business association with a broad domestic and international membership, would anchor the Hub in Ulaanbaatar with a regional learning function extending to Central Asia and other dryland economies facing similar rangeland and drought challenges.

By COP18: By COP18, BCM aims to have mobilized a founding community of Mongolian B4L members, run a sector dialogue series (mining and land rehabilitation, rangeland and cashmere value chains, green finance), built an investment pipeline drawing on the National Green Lab, and convened at least one regional knowledge-exchange session with Central Asia.



B4L Russia Hub

Ecumene Global Forum (Bloom Group Ltd.)

Ecumene is the only UN-supported sustainable development platform in Russia, having hosted discussions with 500+ experts from 40+ countries. The Hub would engage Russian companies in agriculture, energy, finance and infrastructure, with a focus on the Volga basin, Southern Federal District, Siberia and Lake Baikal.

By COP18: By COP18, the Hub plans to have completed its national launch at the Ecumene Global Forum in Moscow, engaged UNFCCC COP31, run a landscape and opportunity assessment, begun investment facilitation with development finance institutions, and scoped regional expansion into Central Asia through a joint water and climate risk study with Gazprombank.
