The United Nations maintains a strict policy of zero tolerance for sexual exploitation and abuse (SEA) — a commitment that applies equally to persons with disabilities, who can face heightened risk and greater barriers to reporting.

Every staff member, volunteer, and partner shares responsibility for creating accessible, safe, and respectful spaces for everyone we serve.

Stop, Prevent, Protect

- STOP – Zero tolerance for inaction on reports of SEA
- PREVENT – Training and accessible awareness for all personnel
- PROTECT – Confidential, survivor-centred support with no retaliation

Accessibility is everyone's responsibility

Ensure reporting channels, information, and support are accessible to persons with disabilities — in format, language, and location.
