

All his life, Ahmid has been interested in the conservation of the planet's biodiversity, a passion that motivated him to travel through several countries around the world to work and learn about organic agriculture and beekeeping. He has collaborated with the International Federation of Organic Agriculture Movements (IFOAM) and the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification, based in Bonn, Germany. Ahmid began his training as a beekeeper, with an emphasis on natural beekeeping, in Kenya in 2012, and then started and managed an ecological apiary in Bonn from 2012 to 2016. He holds specialization studies in biodynamic beekeeping from the Biodynamic Association, a certificate in permaculture by Geoff Lawton, and specialization courses in environmental education and sustainable development. He was recently certified as an organic beekeeper by Ecocolmena and currently pursues a master's program in beekeeping from the Cornell University in the United States of America. Ahmid believes in environmental education as a key mechanism for achieving a new social awakening for the benefit of the world's bees, soil, and ecosystems. Ahmid founded BeeHub in 2018, a social enterprise aimed to promote education and conservation of bees in Guatemala.
