CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES

1. The following affected developing countries were offered financing under the Special Voluntary Fund for participation in the second session of the Conference of the Parties; countries marked with an asterisk (*) are affected least developed countries for which two representatives were financed through the Special Voluntary Fund:

Algeria, Angola*, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belize, Benin*, Bolivia, Botswana*, Brazil, Burkina Faso*, Burundi*, Cameroon, Cape Verde*, Central African Republic*, Chad*, Chile, China, Comoros, Congo (Democratic Republic of), Costa Rica, Cook Islands, Cuba, Djibouti*, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Eritrea*, Ethiopia*, Fiji, Gambia*, Ghana, Guinea*, Guinea Bissau*, Haiti*, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Jamaica, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kiribati, Kyrgyzstan, Lao (People's Democratic Republic), Lebanon, Lesotho*, Liberia, Madagascar*, Malawi*, Mali*, Marshall Islands, Mauritania*, Mongolia, Morocco, Mozambique*, Myanmar*, Namibia, Nauru, Nepal*, Nicaragua, Niger*, Nigeria, Niue, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Rwanda, Saint Lucia, Sao Tome and Principe, South Africa, Sudan*, Swaziland, Syrian Arab Republic, Tadjikistan, Togo*, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Tuvalu, Uganda*, United Republic of Tanzania*, Uzbekistan, Viet Nam, Yemen*, Zambia*, Zimbabwe.

2. A representative of Palestine also received financing under the Special Voluntary Fund for participation in the second session of the Conference of the Parties.

3. In extending assistance to a total of 131 participants, an estimated amount of US\$ 523,000 inclusive of programme support costs was committed.
