PRELIMINARY INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Note by the secretariat

The third session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification will be held from 15 to 26 November 1999 at Recife, Brazil. The present document contains some general information that may be helpful to participants. The session will be hosted by the Government of Brazil in accordance with decision 24/COP.2 of the Conference of the Parties.

1. Venue of the session

The third session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification will be held in the Pernambuco Convention Centre (Centro de Convenções de Pernambuco), situated at Olinda, in the metropolitan area of the city of Recife, at the following address:

The conference will be opened on Monday 15 November 1999 at 3 p.m. in the Plenary Hall. The morning will be devoted to informal consultations. In addition to the Plenary Hall, another meeting room with simultaneous interpretation during normal working hours will be available. Other premises can also be used for informal meetings without interpretation, subject to arrangements made with the secretariat. Working hours will normally be from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

3. National Organizing Committee (NOC)

The Government of Brazil has established a National Organizing Committee (NOC) consisting of members of all ministerial departments involved, relevant authorities from the State of Pernambuco and local authorities from Recife, as well as representatives of other governmental agencies. 4. Hotel accommodation

The NOC has already reserved the necessary accommodation in the town's main hotels at special rates (see list annexed).

5. Accreditation

The credentials of representatives of Parties and the names of alternate representatives and advisers must be communicated either by the Head of State or Government or by the Minister of Foreign Affairs. To ensure full participation in the work of the Conference, it is recommended that representatives of Parties should be provided with full powers to participate in the session and, if necessary, to serve as officers of the Conference of the Parties at its third session and any sessional committees or working groups, as well as officers of the subsidiary bodies established by the Convention.

Credentials must be submitted to the secretariat of the Convention. The Bureau of the Conference of the Parties at its third session will examine the credentials and report to the session.

Observer States, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations must also be accredited.

6. Immigration formalities

The Brazilian Government advises that the immigration formalities will be facilitated in its embassies or consulates, according to prevailing Brazilian regulations. Applications may be submitted, with reference to the Conference, to the nearest Brazilian embassy or consulate.

According to World Health Organization recommendations, participants coming from certain geographic areas must submit their international certificate of vaccination against yellow fever.

7. Customs regulations

Information on customs regulations in force in Brazil may be obtained from any Brazilian embassy or consulate.

8. Recife airport

Recife's international airport welcomes all participants. A reception committee will be present at the airport throughout the Conference and an information office identifiable by the Convention's logo will be established.

Participants will reach their hotels by a commercial transfer service available on arrival.

9. Transport

Given the fact that the Pernambuco Convention Centre is situated outside of the city of Recife (metropolitan area) where most of the hotels are situated, a shuttle service will be arranged by the NOC to provide transport for participants on a commercial basis, between the main hotels and the Conference site.

Details of this transport service as well as its cost will be decided upon in the near future in the light of reservations confirmed by participants.

10. Restaurants

The restaurants of the Pernambuco Convention Centre will be open to participants. In addition, a large number of restaurants in the vicinity of the Convention Centre offer quality services at reasonable prices.

11. Registration

Identity badges will be issued at the time of registration and participants are requested to wear them at all times, since they will be allowed access to the Pernambuco Convention Centre only upon their presentation. Registration will begin at the Conference site at the following times:

Friday 12 November 1999	afternoon from 2 to 5 p.m.
Sunday 14 November 1999	morning from 10 a.m. to noon afternoon from 2 to 5 p.m.

It will continue from 15 November 1999 on the basis of the timetable that will be announced. Details concerning the exact location of the registration counter for national delegations, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations and other observers, as well as for the media and the staff of the United Nations, the specialized agencies and United Nations programmes, will be communicated before the start of the Conference of the Parties.

12. List of speakers

A list of speakers for the special segment as well as for other sessions of the Plenary will be opened at a time and subject to conditions to be announced in the Journal of the General Assembly.

13. Medical services

A medical service will be available in the Pernambuco Convention Centre. In addition, the National Organizing Committee will make the necessary arrangements to cope with any medical emergencies.

14. Telephone and fax services

An office offering telephone and fax facilities on a commercial basis, which will be charged for, will remain open throughout the session at the Pernambuco Convention Centre for the convenience of delegations and other participants. Cellular phone can be rented at the airport.

15. Additional services available in the Pernambuco Convention Centre (Centro de Convenções de Pernambuco) for participants

Participants in the Conference will be able to use the various facilities of the Pernambuco Convention Centre, namely post office (stamps and letter boxes), bank, bar and snack services.

16. Meeting and exhibition facilities
