Summary

In accordance with article 22, paragraph 7 of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification, rules 6 and 7 of the rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP), and decision 26/COP.1, a list of non-governmental organizations proposed for accreditation at the eighth session of the COP is contained herein. A list of national, international, governmental and intergovernmental organizations already accredited to the COP, and an updated list of non-governmental organizations, assuming accreditation of the proposed organizations by the COP at its eighth session, are also included.

I. Background information

1. Article 22, paragraph 7, of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification states: “The United Nations, its specialized agencies and any State member thereof or observers thereto not Party to the Convention, may be represented at sessions of the Conference of the Parties as observers. Any body or agency, whether national or international, governmental or non-governmental, which is qualified in matters covered by the Convention, and which has informed the Permanent Secretariat of its wish to be represented at a session of the Conference of the Parties as an observer, may be so admitted unless at least one third of the Parties present object.” Rules 6 and 7 of the rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP), adopted by decision 1/COP.1, contain provisions to similar effect. Decision 26/COP.1 contains provisions on accrediting non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations to the first and subsequent sessions of the COP.

II. Introduction

2. Assuming accreditation by the COP at its eighth session of the organizations listed in annex I, annex III contains the updated list of non-governmental organizations accredited to the COP.

III. Recommendation

3. In accordance with the provisions mentioned above, the secretariat recommends that the COP at its eighth session accredits as observers the non-governmental organizations listed in annex I.

Promotes the construction of houses with alternative materials so as to reduce the number of trees cut for this purpose. Provides access to cooking gas to poor families with the aim of reducing dependence on wood. Assists the population of the villages to create self-help groups to seek alternative sources of income instead of obtaining immediate benefit from selling trees. Established a training centre to teach stall-feeding techniques to rural women and young people as new solutions against over-grazing. Implements reforestation programmes in areas prone to desertification.
