Paragraph 38

For the existing text *substitute*

38. As indicated in Article 26 of the Convention, national reports are mainly used for assessing measures for implementation and their effectiveness in achieving the Convention objectives. The Global Biodiversity Outlook is one of the CBD key documents that provide analysis of implementation. The fourth national report will be used to measure progress towards the achievement of the 2010 Biodiversity Target, as well as to contribute to the third edition of the Global Biodiversity Outlook. In addition, the CBD shares reported information and experience through the clearing-house mechanism (CHM),¹ which posts all national reports, coded, where possible, to facilitate online analysis and comparison of responses and to draw out particular similarities, differences and lessons.
