*Summary*

The Conference of the Parties (COP), by decision 15/COP.10 decided that future sessions of the Committee for the Review of the Implementation of the Convention (CRIC) should review the accessibility of the information on best practices.

By the same decision, the COP requested the secretariat to identify recommended databases for information collected on the themes of best practices identified in decision 13/COP.9, with a view to transferring the sustainable land management best practices stored in the performance review and assessment of implementation system, to the recommended database.

A call for expressions of interest was open from 21 November 2012 to 30 January 2013, in order to identify relevant institutions and organizations interested in supporting the CRIC in the compilation and dissemination of best practices on “sustainable land management technologies, including adaptation” and “funding and resource mobilization”. A total of 18 institutions submitted the online questionnaire that was published by the secretariat.

This document contains a list of institutions and organizations which have

responded to the call and which meet the basic requirements as described in the call. As regards the response on “funding and resource mobilization”, the call did not yield the range of institutions that was expected. The secretariat therefore plans to continue with the consultation.

Recommendations on possible actions on this matter to be taken by the Convention’s institutions and subsidiary bodies, as well as by relevant partners, are contained in document ICCD/CRIC(11)/13.
